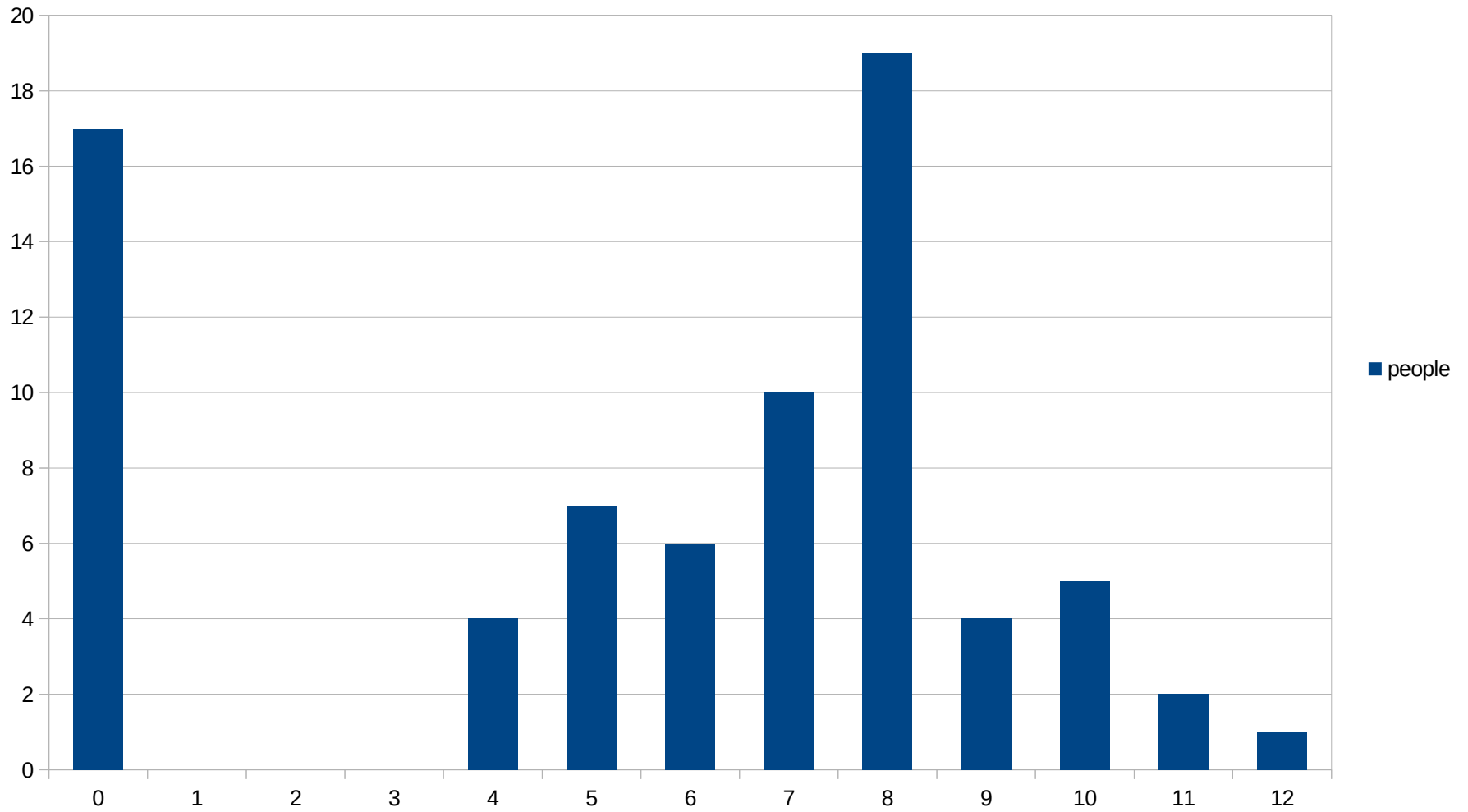


11. How many hours a day does your father devote to his work outside the house?



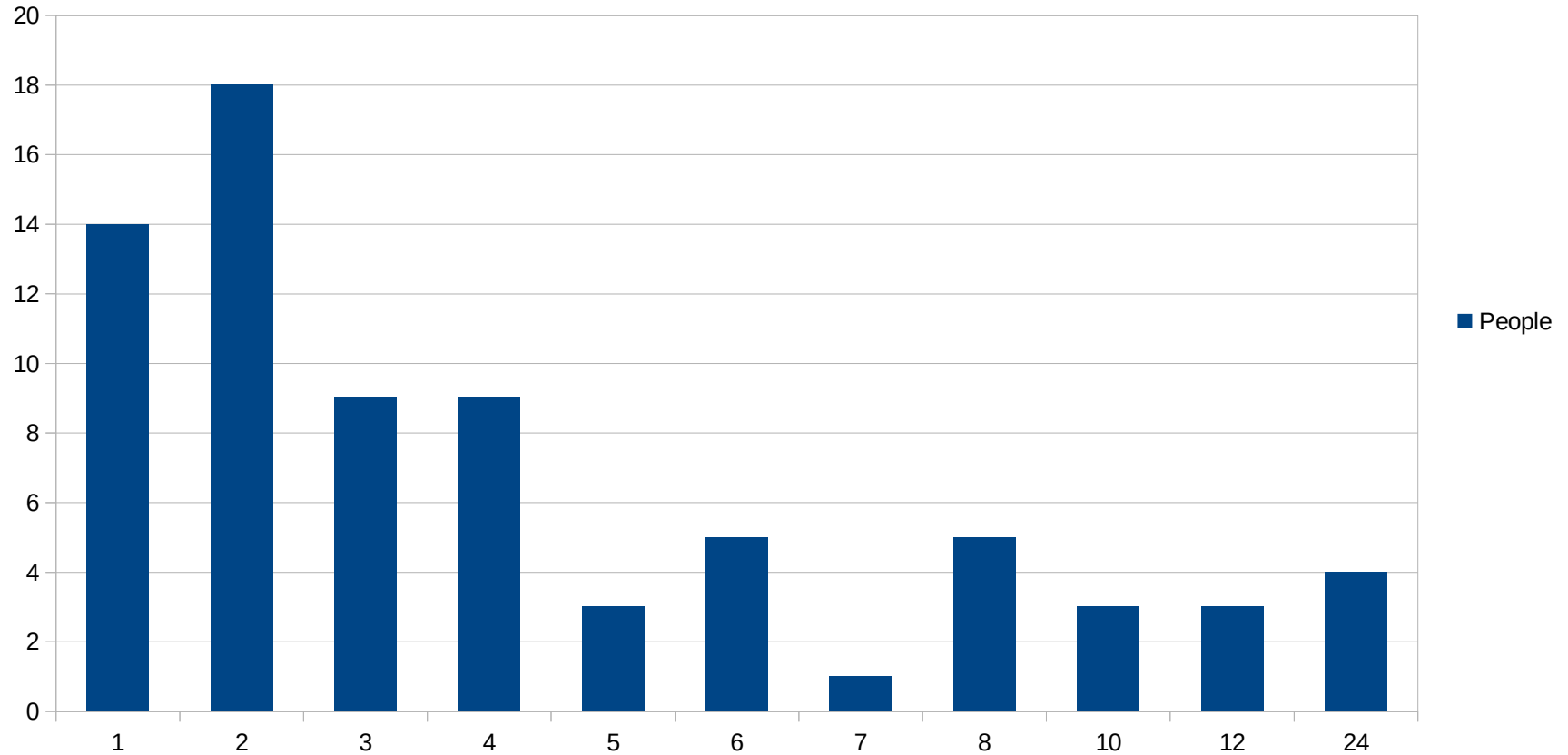
