As a girl, you have to be strong, powerful and you need to know how to select your friends and companions.

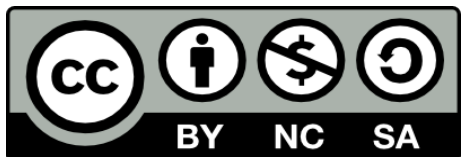
As a man, you need to know that the change starts with you, and then to convince or persuade your friends that you are not cool if you are doing harm, even if the victim is a man or woman.
